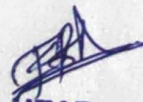

Synopsis

A Hands-on Training Program in Vermitechnology (2025-26) was jointly organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and the Department of Zoology under the Lead College Activity. The program aimed to provide participants with both theoretical knowledge and practical exposure to vermicomposting techniques, highlighting its significance in sustainable agriculture and environmental conservation.

The training session commenced with an introductory address delivered by Mr. Rahul Patil, IQAC Coordinator, & Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology. This was followed by the introduction of the resource person by Dr. Anuradha Shinde, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology. Mr. Tejas Lengare, who was invited as the Resource Person. He delivered an informative session on the importance of vermitechnology in modern agriculture, explaining the concept of vermicomposting, types of earthworms used such as *Eisenia fetida*, raw materials required, and the benefits of vermicompost in enhancing soil fertility and crop productivity. Emphasis was also laid on eco-friendly farming practices and effective organic waste recycling.

During the practical session, students actively participated in the preparation of a vermicompost unit. They were trained in the selection of suitable containers, proper layering of organic waste, maintenance of moisture levels, and care of earthworms. The resource person demonstrated appropriate methods for monitoring temperature, ensuring aeration, and harvesting vermicompost. The interactive nature of the session encouraged students to clarify doubts and engage actively in the learning process.

The program significantly enhanced the practical skills of students and strengthened their understanding of sustainable agricultural practices. Overall, the hands-on training program conducted under the Lead College Activity was informative, effective, and instrumental in promoting environmental awareness and self-reliance among students. Outcomes

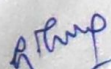
Students gained practical knowledge of vermicompost preparation and management.
